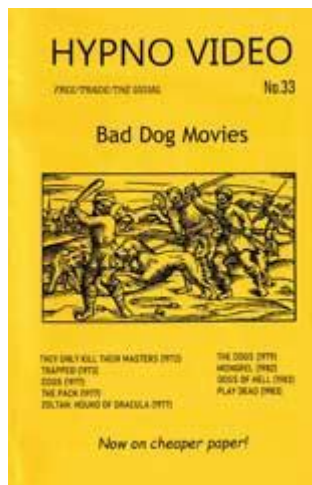
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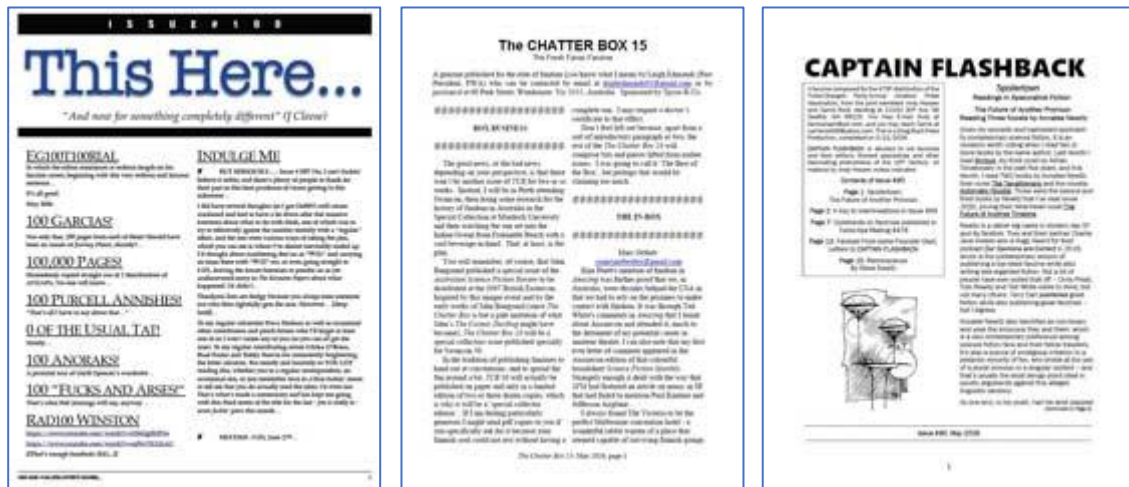

- **Anderson, Taylor.** *Fleet of Ghosts. [Destroyermen: Scout Cadre #1].* Ace, 44.00 hc.

Naturalist Courtney Bradford is given leave to organize the Corps of Discovery, a motley company formed of veterans of the Great War from all over the Alliance. On board the rebuilt Walker, now a school ship, they set out to investigate some strange reports of a region in the Pacific. And there they find a great battered fleet made up of strange ships, perhaps transported there in the same way that Walker came to this world.

- **Archer, Amy.** *Nemesis Mine. Voyager,* 25.99 tp.

Nobody is more surprised than Cyrus to learn that he's no longer considered the greatest villain in the land of Athaca. Sure, he's lying about the fact that his magical power is making flowers grow. And maybe lately he's spent more time embroidering pillowcases than tormenting the locals. Enter the hero Maximillian: the realm's golden boy, complete with a blinding smile, chiseled abs, and an infuriating habit of spreading hope and joy.

- **Arden, Katherine.** *The Unicorn Hunters. Del Rey,* 41.99 hc.

Anne of Brittany was a child when France invaded. Now she is a young woman, sovereign duchess of an occupied realm, and France means to crown their conquest by marrying her to their king. Her only hope of resisting conquest is another alliance sealed with marriage, so Anne arranges a daring last gambit: a secret betrothal to Charles of France's greatest rival. While pretending compliance with France, Anne plans a unicorn hunt in the forest Broceliande. A bit of pointless pageantry. A diversion so she can wed in secret. Or so she thinks.

- **Bado, Chinaza.** *Birth of a Dynasty. [Birth of a Dynasty #1].* Voyager, 24.99 tp.

After witnessing the massacre of everyone he's ever known and loved, M'Kuru Mukundi, the sole surviving member of the High Noble House Mukundi of Madada, vows revenge. M'kuru flees to a small village where he hides under the guise of farm boy Khalil Rausi... unaware that the real Khalil's father is the bloodthirsty General of Zenzele's army, and under the direction of the King's scheming son, Prince Effiom, was responsible for the murder of M'kuru's people.

- **Behzadi, Bitia.** *Letters From The Last Apothecary. [Tressport Magic #1].* Hay House, 24.99 tp.

Josephine Pinova doesn't believe in fate. Yet, it must be fate when she walks into one of the last magical apothecaries in the city and they offer her a job after she's just been fired. Struggling against a tide of anti-magic sentiment amidst the city's rapid industrialization, the shop is slated to close in six short months unless Josie can save it.

- **Bennett, Robert Jackson.** *A Trade of Blood: An Ana and Din Mystery. [Shadow of the Leviathan #3].* Del Rey, 39.99 hc.

In the canton of Sapirdad, two of the Empire's most powerful families are moments away from going to war with each other, their hundreds of retainers gathered with swords drawn. To de-escalate matters, someone must do the impossible: prove that one family's eldest son is innocent of a gruesome and unforgivable murder, despite the incontrovertible evidence against him. A task for Ana Dolabra and her assistant Din.

- **Berry, Jedediah.** *Kill All Wizards. Tor.com,* 34.99 hc.

The barbarian traveled far to consult the wizards of the empire. Instead of lending their aid, they ensorcelled him, exploited his strength, and stole his sword. They should not have done that. Now the barbarian plans to kill every wizard who wronged him, even if that means blending in with their vile society: dressing in finery, taking tea in exclusive clubs,

and reserving the best box at the theater. Oh, he hates it all with the fiery passion of his savage heart - but not as much as he hates these wizards.

- **Blackburry, Sabrina. *Half Wylde*. W by Wattpad, 38.99 hc.**

Wren has spent her life hiding - hiding the truth about herself. She's half-fae. The local villagers are afraid of her and only her adoptive father, Bryn, and her teacher, a witch named Mila, care whether she lives or dies. When their village is attacked, and Bryn is killed, Mila urges Wren to flee into the woods. There she encounters the mysterious but frightening Thain who offers to take her to the Wyldes, the land of the fae creatures.

- **Briar, Shiloh. *Hopeless Necromantic*. Orbit, 25.99 tp.**

Helspira must play escort to Sikras - a frustratingly handsome necromancer with the power to raise the dead - as he attempts a mission that he's failed twice before; stopping an undead army at the edges of the kingdom. No one thinks he will succeed. Not even Sikras. But the more time the two spend together, the more they find they can imagine a brighter future.

- **Broadbent, Carissa. *Six Scorched Roses*. [Crowns of Nyaxia]. Bramble, 27.99 tp.**

Short novel. Six roses. Six vials of blood. Six visits to a vampire who could be her salvation... or her damnation. Lilith has been dying since the day she was born. But while she long ago came to terms with her own imminent death, the deaths of everyone she loves is an entirely different matter. As her town slowly withers in the clutches of a mysterious god-cursed illness, she takes matters into her own hands.

- **Butler, D. J. *Hell on Wheels*. Baen, 37.00 hc.**

The year is 1975. Silas drives a red Pontiac GTO. Trapped in the back of his muscle car are the ghost of his sister Betty and half of the demon that killed her. He doesn't know how she died, and he hasn't figured out how to save her yet, but he knows that if he spends three days in any one place, the other half of the demon will catch up, kill him, and drag Betty down to hell. Silas works as a scout, messenger, courier, herald, and sometimes spy across the weird, fragmented, magical world of Other America.

- **Cahill, Ryan. *The Fall*. [The Bound and the Broken]. The Broken Binding, 27.99 hc.**

A novella taking place 400 years before the events of Of Blood and Fire. A red moon rose over the continent of Epheria and the world changed forever. In the city of Ilnaen, brothers and sisters turn upon each other, dragons war in fire and fury, and gods reach their hands into the world. This is a night that will echo through all time. This is the fall of the Order.

- **Cambias, James L. *The Ishtar Deception*. [The Billion Worlds #4]. Baen, 25.00 tp.**

At the end of the Tenth Millennium, Sabbath Okada, agent of a nameless branch of Deimos' labyrinthine government, comes to the vast city of Ishtar on Venus to investigate the suspicious death of an undercover agent. His companion, Daslakh, is an old and cunning AI with its own self-imposed mission: to act as Okada's conscience. Searching for the truth takes Sabbath and Daslakh to the glittering towers of Ishtar's elite, a brutal combat sport arena, and the unforgiving, wind-lashed face of the highest peak on Venus.

- **Carey, M. R. *The Tinder Box*. Orbit, 25.99 tp.**

Wounded in his county's endless wars, former soldier Mag Tresti finds work in the home of a reclusive widow, Jannae Mirchella. But Jannae is more than she seems. A witch of great skill and might, she hides her powers and her deep-laid plans behind a mask of harmless respectability. When a dead demon falls out of the sky, the fates of the soldier and the

witch are irrevocably intertwined. On the demon's body Mag finds a tinderbox - an artefact of terrifying magical power that can not only grant his every wish, but also change the fate of nations.

- **Carson, Scott (=Michael Koryta). *Departure* 37. Emily Bestler, 26.00 tp.**

On a clear October day, the American skies empty after hundreds of pilots refuse to fly, triggering a complete ground stop. The pilots all received disturbing, middle-of-the-night calls from their mothers, and each mother had a simple and urgent request: do not fly today. There are a few concerning elements to the calls. None of the mothers remember making them - and some of the mothers are dead. While the nation's military chiefs and artificial intelligence experts mobilize in search of answers, a 16-year-old girl named Charlie on the coast of Maine watches a strange, silvery balloon drift across the water and toward her home - a place she loathes.

- **Chapman, Clay. *Acquired Taste*. Titan, 24.99 tp.**

A collection of 25 of his stories.

- **Chu, Wesley. *The Art of Legend*. [War Arts Saga #3]. Del Rey, 26.99 tp.**

With war on the horizon--and rumors of the Khan's return brewing--a band of unlikely allies are also on their own missions. There's Sali, a gruff warrior who is also forging a path different from the one her culture created for her, and Qisami, an assassin whose cold heart might actually be made of gold. And Taishi has gathered a band of other elderly grandmasters to help Jian live up to his destiny. Because some heroes aren't simply born legends--they choose to become legendary. And great heroes do not stand alone, but are stronger together.

- **Clarke, August. *Metal From Heaven*. Erewhon, 24.95 tp.**

A bloody lesbian revenge tale and political fantasy set in a glittering world transformed by industrial change - and simmering class warfare. He who controls ichorite controls the world. A malleable metal more durable than steel, ichorite is a toxic natural resource fueling national growth, and ambitious industrialist Yann Chauncey helms production of this miraculous ore. Working his foundry is an underclass of destitute workers...

- **Cornell, Paul. *The Lychford Collection 2*. [Witches of Lychford Omnibus #2]. Tor.com, 40.99 tp.**

The Lights Go Out in Lychford, *Last Stand in Lychford*, and *Gnomes of Lychford* collected in the second *Lychford* omnibus edition.

- **Crocker, Ed. *Moonfall*. [Everlands Trilogy #2]. St. Martin's, 43.00 hc.**

In the last vampire city of First Light, the rebels know the truth about the Grays. But nothing has changed. Sam has a plan to bring the whole rotten city down: a plan of peace, not violence. But in this city, the best laid plans have a way of falling apart, and she'll need the help of the city's ex ruler and former enemy if she's to avoid a bloodbath.

- **Croucher, Lex. *The Unmagical Life of Briar Jones*. Voyager, 42.00 hc.**

For as long as they can remember, Briar Jones dreamed of attending the Temple School of Thaumaturgy, an elite boarding school. When, at age eleven, Briar's best friend, Sebastian Wolfe, gets an acceptance letter and Briar doesn't, their childhood friendship is shattered. Seven years later, a summer job advert appears: a temp position sorting through the junk in Temple's attics. And when Briar takes it, they discover that quiet, sensitive Seb, the boy they once loved more than anything else in the world, has become Bastian, a beautiful, arrogant villain feared by the entire school.

- **Curtis, Grace. *Heaven's Graveyard*. DAW, 39.00 hc.**

Two thousand years after the events of *Idolfire*, the world is on the brink of war, and the discovery of the enchanted city of Nivela threatens to push it over the brink. Archeologist Cod's old teacher has made the discovery of a lifetime. But her home is Palgaro, and the discovery - the ruins of the enchanted city of Nivela - is set to change the world. And not for the better...

- **Day, Alyssa. *Nobody's Quest*. [*Nobody Chronicles #1*]. Red Tower, 45.99 hc.**

For a hundred years, Altarra has burned. Corvynne, the goddess of war, has conquered kingdom after kingdom, leaving only ruin in her wake. Every prophecy says the same thing - nobody can defeat her. And after a century of failure, someone finally takes that literally. When the goddess Artemisen chooses Soli Graymind - a nobody who suffers from chronic depression - to lead one last desperate quest, the world laughs.

- **DiLouie, Craig. *Summer Fun Massacre*. [*Slasher Season #1*]. Run For It, 25.99 tp.**

[Canadian author]. Summer 1992 at Camp Summer Fun. Responding to reports of a blood-curdling howl near the camp, sheriff's deputy Tom arrives too late to save anyone except a single brutalized teen. The killer nowhere to be found. Mary, a survivor of an attack at the camp in 1983, is convinced that the killer is not human but instead a rural legend known as the Hungry Hare. The sheriff wants the case closed, but refuses to believe in folklore.

- **Elliott, Kate. *Witch Roads*. [*Witch Roads #1*]. Tor, 25.99 tp.**

When an arrogant prince (and his equally arrogant entourage) gets stuck in Orledder Halt as part of brutal political intrigue, competent and sunny deputy courier Elen--once a child slave meant to shield noblemen from the poisonous Pall--is assigned to guide him through the hills to reach his destination. When she warns him not to enter the haunted Spires, the prince doesn't heed her advice, and the man who emerges from the towers isn't the same man who entered.

- **England, Autumn K. *FIELD GUIDE FOR THE FORMERLY VILLAINOUS*. Poisoned Pen, 28.99 tp.**

When Oaklin Nettlewood accidentally joined an evil world-ending cult, mind control magic forced them to do unspeakable things. Later, liberated, with a spell-damaged memory and whole bushel of trauma, Oaklin escapes to a small farm on the edge of Mossley's Rest and swears an oath. After all the things they were forced to do with their magic, they will never use it again. Ever.

- **English, Shannon. *Endless Blue Beneath*. [*Daughters of Atlantea #1*]. Orbit, 25.99 tp.**

On land Eppie will never be anything more than the outcast girl who kissed the grocer's daughter. But stolen from the shore, she is transformed. Eppie is stronger, swifter - and hungrier. Human flesh smells like heaven on earth, and Eppie is ravenous. She has become a monster of the deep - a mermaid. And when Eppie meets Marie, a stunningly beautiful mermaid with a past as shadowed as her raven-black scales, she finds she no longer needs to resist the desires that were denied to her on land.

- **Flynn, Chris. *Orpheus Nine*. Hodder, 29.99 tp.**

In the small, sleepy town of Gattan, population 7448, it happened at eleven o'clock on a Saturday morning. At the local soccer field, only one boy, aged ten years and one week, remained standing as the brothers, sisters and parents of his teammates realised the horror they were witnessing. Their screams split the sky. One hundred and thirty million died that first day. Every day since, on the morning of a child's ninth birthday, it happens again. No one knows why.

- **Frost, Jeaniene.** *A Curse of Beasts and Magic*. [*Beautiful and Beastly* #1]. Bramble, 41.99 hc.

Raine Stone is living a nightmare. Ever since she survived the attack that killed her family, she's been hiding a terrible secret - and a Beast inside her. It feeds on violence and chaos, but she restrains its urges by playing vigilante on the city streets. Until one night, Raine uses the Beast's energy to heal an elderly gentleman from a seemingly random attack and discovers a new world of danger - literally.

- **Gaither, S. M.** *What Echoes in the Dark*. [*What Blooms From Death* #2]. Cornerstone, 22.99 tp.

The magic reviving the decayed realm of Noctaris is unstable. Unpredictable. As the survivors of her ravaged world look to her for salvation, Lorien offers Nova a dangerous bargain. Undo a curse that ruined him centuries ago, restore the scattered pieces of his true self, and she can have Aleks back.

- **Golden, Christopher.** *The Night Birds*. Griffin, 26.00 tp.

Charlie Book and Ruby Cahill's love ended in heartbreak years ago. Charlie now lives aboard the Christabel, an old freighter half-sunken off the shore of Galveston, with a grove of mangrove trees growing up through its deck. Then Ruby shows up with her murdered sister's girlfriend Bella, and Bella's infant child, hoping to hide aboard the Christabel from a coven of witches. As they leave shore they see the night birds flying, scouring the coastline for their prey.

- **Gratton, Tessa.** *The Shape of Monsters*. [*The Moon Heresies* #2]. Orbit, 25.99 tp.

Iriset - prodigy, outlaw, now sunderer - has broken the Moon-Eater god's prison at the heart of the empire. But the consequences of her actions land her in a city of monsters where the heretical magic of human architecture is freely practiced, and the only person she knows - and can trust - is Lyric, the emperor she's lied to and loved in equal measure.

- **Gruender, Nataly.** *Selkie*. Grand Central, 25.99 tp.

Seven years ago, Quinn finally dared to transform from a seal into a human and took her first steps on land. As a selkie, she is both a daughter of land and sea. But when a human stole her pelt, he stole her freedom as well, forcing Quinn to become his wife and bear his children. 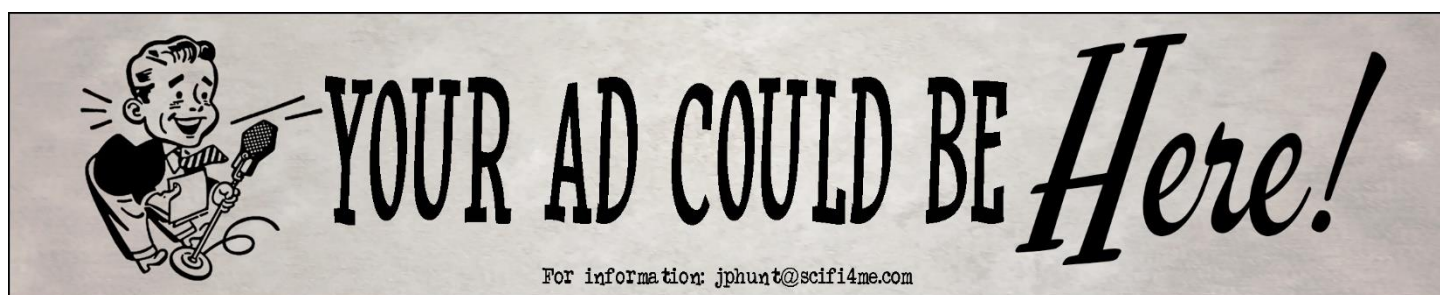

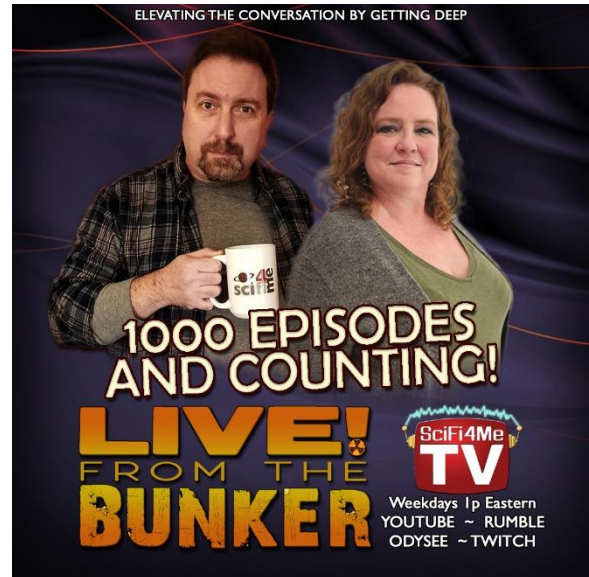
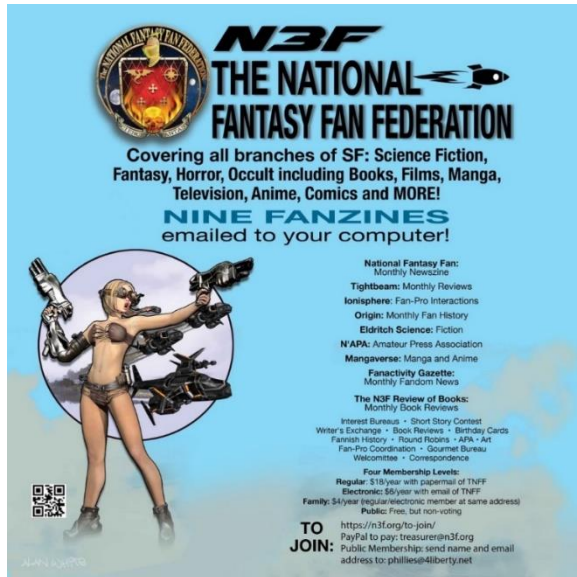
